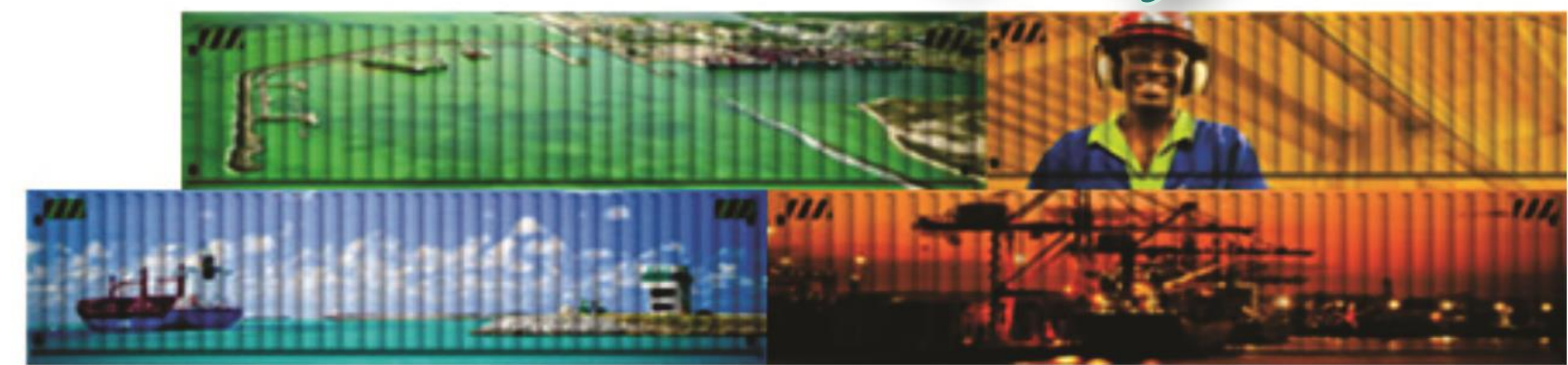

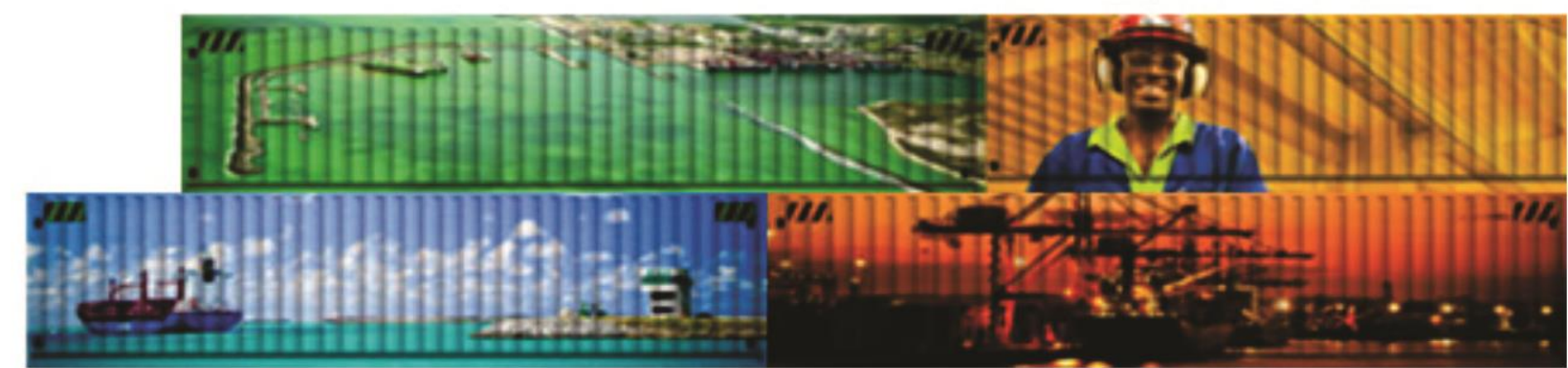
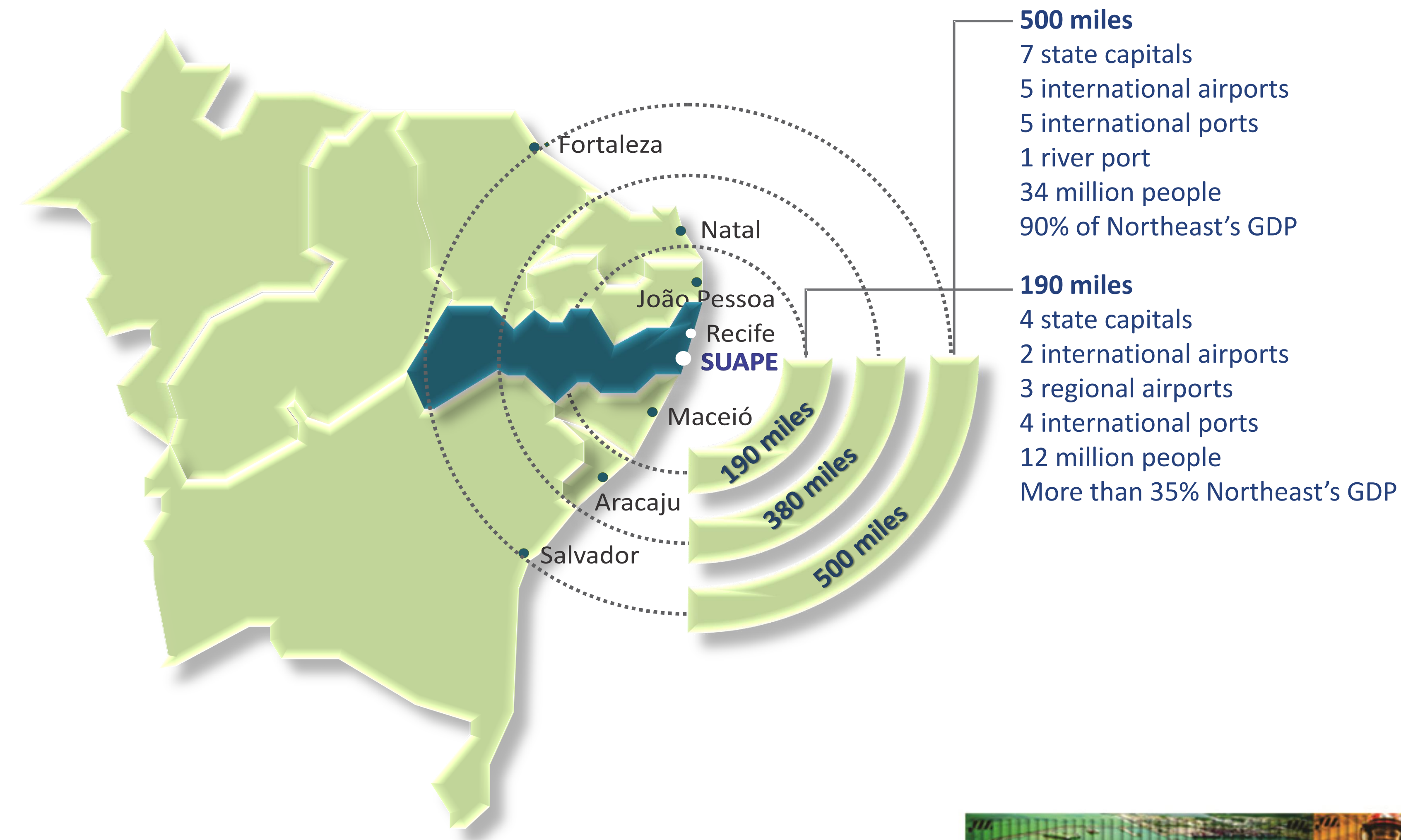

Hub Port - One of the main shipping routes



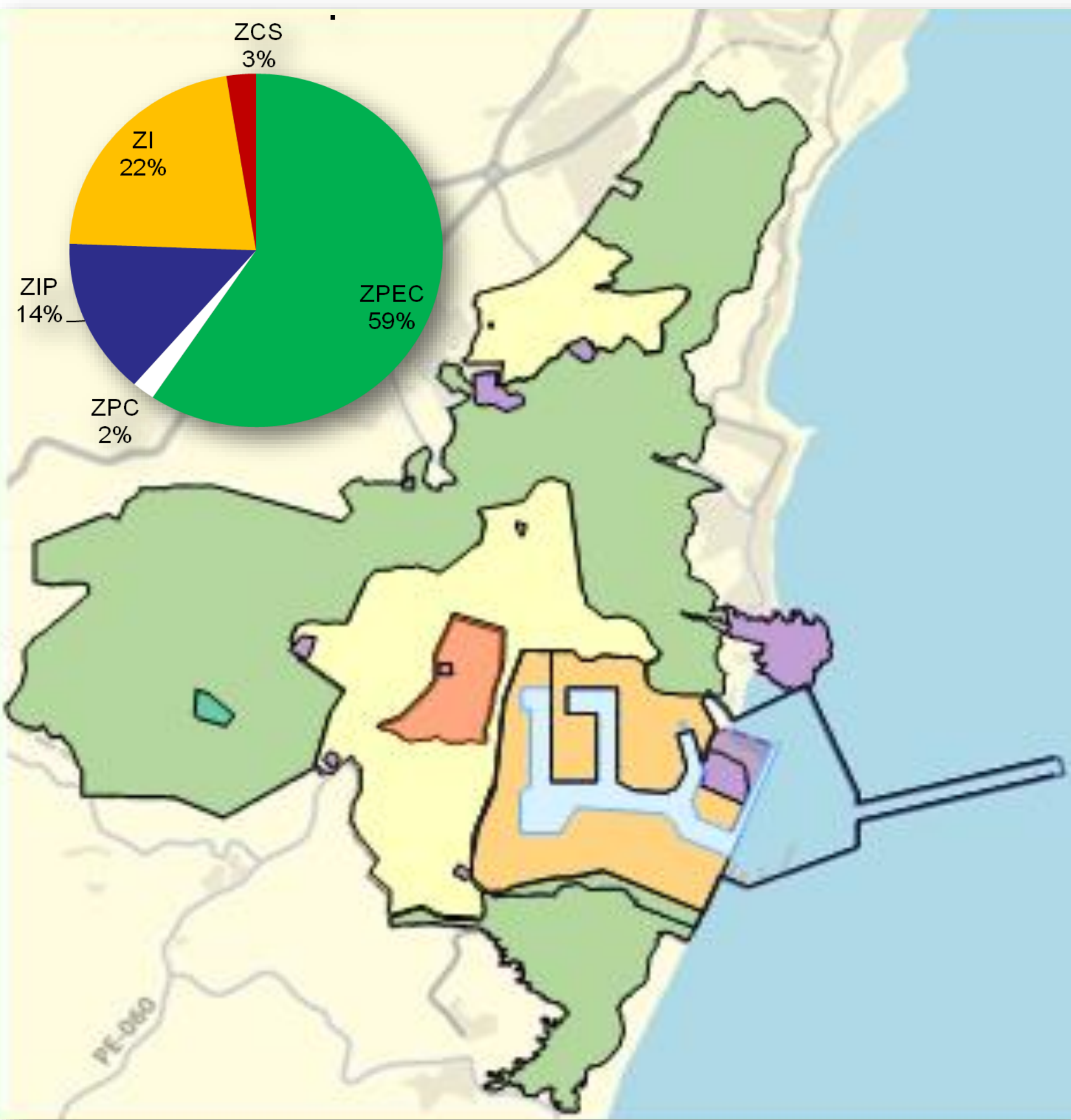


Logistic Center in Brazilian Northeast



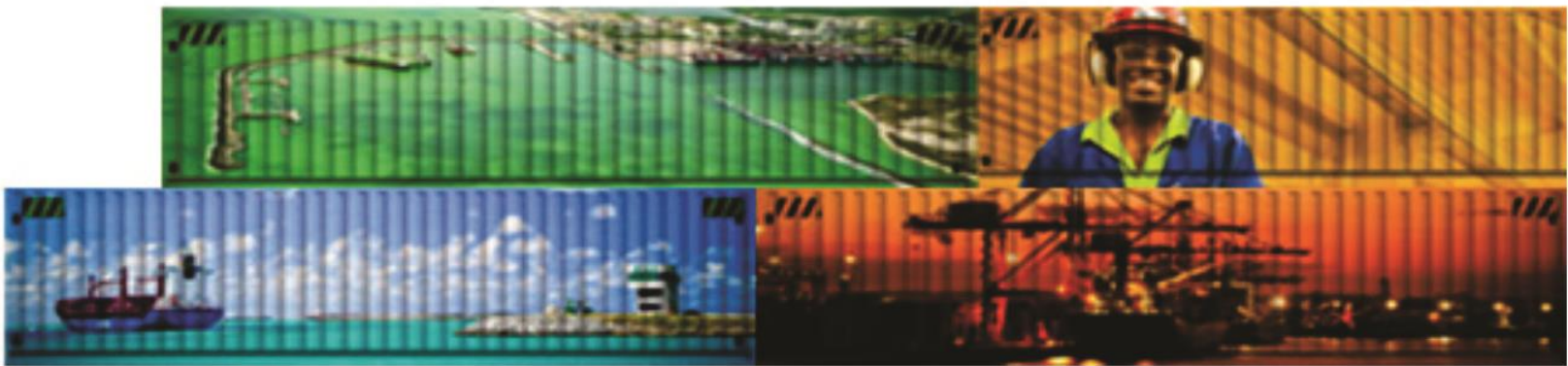

Second Terminal of Containers (Berths 6 and 7)

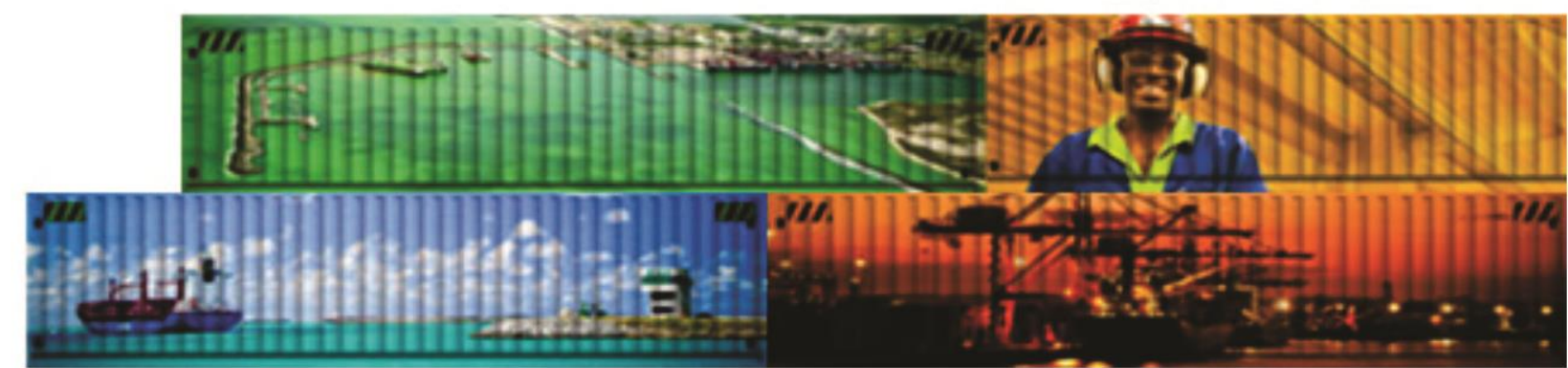


- Two berths (6 and 7) with 771.10 m;

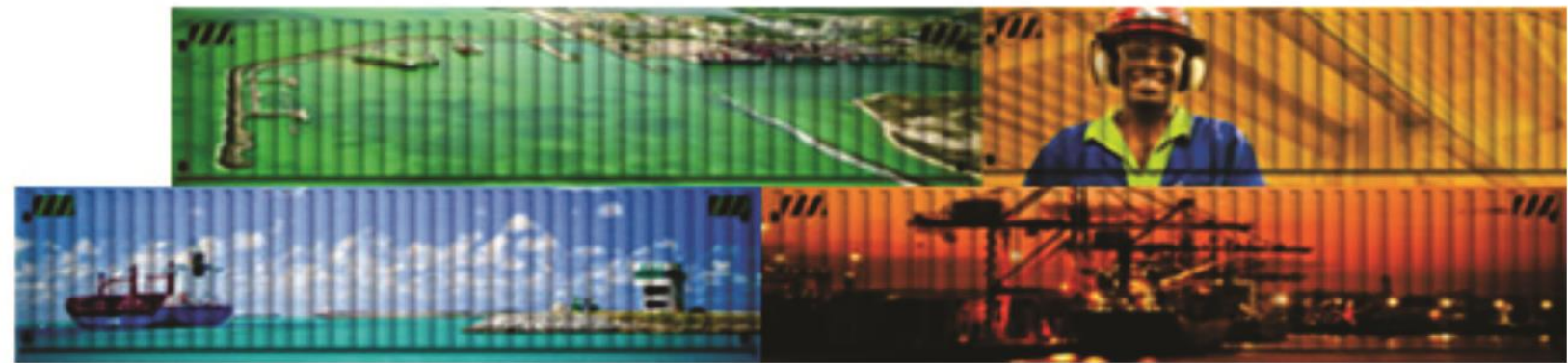
